Dr. Ross had graduated from the University of Toronto in 1971 and had practiced in a small town, Tottenham, Ontario since then. It is a general dentistry practice with an emphasis on treating facial pain on a referral basis.

He has been using surgical lasers since 1992 and low level lasers (Photobiomodulation) since 1993. Dr. Ross has been a member of the Academy of Laser Dentistry since its formation in 1993. He holds Standard Proficiency and Advanced Proficiency from ALD and also he is a Certified Course Provider from them as well. Dr. Ross is a member of the American Society of Laser Medicine and Surgery and holds fellowship status with them. In 2015 he has received the Leon Goldman Award for clinical excellence from ALD. Dr. Ross is a member of NAAALT (North American Association for Photobiomodulation) and he is a past president of this organization.

Dr. Ross had given over 200 lectures on laser both nationally and internationally and has published approximately 15 laser articles and had written chapters on Low Level Lasers for two textbooks. He also does peer review for four laser journals.

Allow ALD members to write the standard proficiency exam

Laser physics for all laser wavelengths, clinical applications of all wavelengths, laser safety, illustration and hands-on practice with various laser wavelengths.

ALD Standard Proficiency exam

There are two parts:

A hands on examination where you must discuss settings for various laser procedures as well as knowledge about your laser setup and safety precautions.

A 75 question written exam which must be completed immediately after the completion of the course. This course is given and marked by ALD.

Note All people completing the ALD SP exam must have completed an introductory laser course. Any CDLI course can be considered an introductory course.
