Dr. Ross had graduated from the University of Toronto in 1971 and had practiced in a small town, Tottenham, Ontario since then. It is a general dentistry practice with an emphasis on treating facial pain on a referral basis.

He has been using surgical lasers since 1992 and low level lasers (Photobiomodulation) since 1993. Dr. Ross has been a member of the Academy of Laser Dentistry since its formation in 1993. He holds Standard Proficiency and Advanced Proficiency from ALD and also he is a Certified Course Provider from them as well. Dr. Ross is a member of the American Society of Laser Medicine and Surgery and holds fellowship status with them. In 2015 he has received the Leon Goldman Award for clinical excellence from ALD. Dr. Ross is a member of NAALT (North American Association for Photobiomodulation) and he is a past president of this organization.

Dr. Ross had given over 200 lectures on laser both nationally and internationally and has published approximately 15 laser articles and had written chapters on Low Level Lasers for two textbooks. He also does peer review for four laser journals.

The course will introduce you Photobiomodulation, a revolutionary new field of dentistry which can change the way we practice dentistry. Photobiomodulation uses low power laser light to create a biological change in the cell. This can lead to reduced pain after dental surgery (and reduced need for pain medication), faster healing of wounds, nerve regeneration, dental analgesia so more restorative procedures can be done without local, treatment of oral lesions such as cold sores and treatment of muscle pain.

In addition you will be taught how to successfully treat 80-90% of the facial pain patients in your practice but most importantly you will learn the cases to avoid that would cause problems for you. You will learn the anatomy and physiology of the components of the masticatory system.

All attendees will receive a manual illustrating all techniques and a literature handout so you can be confident all techniques discussed meet Evidence-Based criteria.
